

OMNIBUS REPEAL BY-LAW

1. The purpose of this By-law is to repeal existing By-laws of the Town of Port Hawkesbury which are:
 - a) outdated
 - b) no longer enforced, or
 - c) are now covered by provincial legislation or more comprehensive By-laws.

2. The following By-laws are repealed:
 - a) By-law re: Poll Tax passed March 8, 1919 and approved March 31, 1919
 - b) By-law re: Closing of Shops passed May 5, 1919 as approved May 20, 1919 and all subsequent amendments
 - c) By-law re: Licensing Trucks & Carriages passed March 11, 1925 as approved March 19, 1925
 - d) By-law re: Motor Vehicles approved July 4, 1952 as approved July 17, 1953
 - e) By-law re: Petty Trades passed August 6, 1954 as approved August 16, 1954
 - f) By-law re: Licenses and Permits passed August 5, 1955 as approved August 31, 1955
 - g) By-law re: Closing of Restaurants passed April 5, 1957 as approved April 26, 1957
 - h) By-law re: Defective Premises passed April 11, 1958 as approved April 17, 1958
 - i) By-law re: Sewers passed November 24, 1958 as approved December 22, 1958 and amended August 7, 1959 as approved August 18, 1959
 - j) By-law re: Building passed March 6, 1959 as approved March 27, 1959
 - k) By-law re: Council Meetings passed February 2, 1960 as amended March 21, 1960
 - l) By-law re: Wards passed October 19, 1960 as approved November 15, 1960
 - m) By-law re: Fireworks passed November 6, 1962 as amended December 14, 1962
 - n) By-law re: Unsightly Premises passed April 28, 1975 as approved May 13, 1975 as amended June 23, 1977 as approved August 31, 1977
 - o) By-law re: Voters' Meetings passed April 18, 1978 as approved July 12, 1978
 - p) Town Clerk and Treasurer By-Law passed April 18, 1978 as approved May 15, 1978 as amended August 27, 1979 as approved October 19, 1979
 - q) Bicycle By-Law passed April 18, 1978 as approved July 12, 1978
 - r) Plebiscite By-law passed April 18, 1978 as approved July 28, 1978
 - s) Travel Expense By-law passed June 14, 1988 as approved March 10, 1989.
