2019 SPRING HYDRANT FLUSHING AND MAIN PROGRAM

The Port Hawkesbury Water Utility advises our customers that fire hydrant flushing of water mains **will begin Sunday, June 2 and continue to Friday, June 14**. This activity will occur in all areas of the Town of Port Hawkesbury served by the Port Hawkesbury Water Utility.

This work will take place between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Sunday to Friday, until completion. Hydrant flushing activities are carried out during overnight hours to cause the least amount of inconvenience for Port Hawkesbury customers.

Discoloured water and pressure fluctuations may occur during the flushing program. If discolouration of water occurs, it will not pose a health risk, and should disappear shortly. Customers are advised to visually check the water before use during the flushing time frame.

The Port Hawkesbury Water Utility is working to ensure that your water system is ready for peak summertime use. The hydrant and distribution system flushing program provides a spring cleaning and full exercise of the entire distribution system.
