



Blue Bag #1 Plastics

3 BAG LIMIT, CLEAN AND DRY

- All beverage containers
- All milk containers
- Glass bottles and jars
- Aluminum tin/steel cans
- Clean aluminum pie plates, foil & trays
- Plastic containers and packaging (#1-7):**
- Cookies and sweets trays
- Plastic bottles, jars and containers
- Shampoo and conditioner bottles
- Cleaning fluid bottles
- Laundry detergent jugs (no boxes)
- Yogurt and pudding containers
- Empty plastic bags (bread, grocery and shopping)

FYI: Clean beverage containers (excluding milk cartons) can be returned to the Port Hawkesbury Enviro-Depot for a refund.

Blue Bag #2 Papers

3 BAG LIMIT, CLEAN AND DRY

- Newsprint
- Paper egg cartons
- Phone books
- Paper (incl. shredded paper)
- Boxboard (cereal and tissue boxes)
- Envelopes (incl. plastic windows)
- File folders
- Flyers, magazines and catalogues
- Glossy flyers and paper
- Soft cover books
- Hard cover books (covers removed)
- Paper towel and toilet paper cores
- Corrugated cardboard (flattened, bundled and tied, not greater than 2 feet x 8 feet x 8 inches)
- Paper carry out trays
- Paper bags

FYI: Soiled/wet paper can contaminate a whole bag of dry, non-contaminated paper which will make the paper unable to be recycled.

Please place paper products contaminated with food residue in the green bin.



Green Carts Organic Waste

1 CART PER HOUSEHOLD

- Nuts and nut shells
- Vegetable and fruits
- Bread and baked goods
- Grains pasta and rice
- Coffee grinds, filters, tea leaves, tea bags, wooden stir sticks
- Egg shells, dairy products
- Mayo, salad dressings, jams, sauces and peanut butter
- Meat products
- Cooking oils, lards and fats
- Leaves, twigs and branches
- Grass clippings, hay
- Sawdust and wood shavings
- Soiled or wet paper:**
- Towels and napkins
- Baking soda and baking powder boxes
- Paper plates
- Sugar and flour bags

FYI: Do not place branches more than 2" in diameter in the cart or allow branches to keep the green cart lid open. The lid must be able to close.

Garbage Clear Bag

6 BAG LIMIT

- All styrofoam
- Disposable hot and cold drink cups
- Chip and cookie wrappers
- Soiled saran wrap and aluminum foil
- Disposable diapers
- Feminine hygiene products
- Toothpaste tubes
- Tooth, hair and lint brushes
- Soiled clothing and textiles
- All gift wrap, ribbons, bows, broken jewelry and photographs
- Crayons, markers, pencils and pens
- Used Kleenex and tissue
- Broken glass, lightbulbs
- Empty motor oil containers
- Empty, dried, paint cans (covers must be removed)
- Kitty litter and dog droppings
- Ashes (MUST be cold)

Household batteries (AAA, AA, etc.) can be dropped off to Canadian Tire for recycling.

Used Oil can also be dropped off to Canadian Tire.

Full paint cans, and electronic peripherals can be dropped off at the Enviro-Depot for recycling. Their phone number is 902-625-2448.
