1. Call to Order

A Public Meeting of the Port Hawkesbury Town Council was held in the Shannon Studio, PHCC, Tuesday, February 3, 2015 and called to order by Mayor MacLean at 7:00 p.m.

2. Gallery Presentations

- a) Regulated Child Care in Nova Scotia Mary L. Delaney
- Ms. Delaney provided an overview of child care options in Nova Scotia and those available in Port Hawkesbury, Victoria County and Whycocomagh. The main challenges facing families in the area are costs associated with child care and the lack of trained staff to address the gap in infant care and facilities from accepting more children. Ms. Delaney stated there is a need for a universal child care program in the province and that Council could assist by providing feedback and comments through a provincial child care review.
- b) Introduction Curtis Doucet, New Fire Chief, Port Hawkesbury Volunteer Fire Department Mayor MacLean welcomed and introduced Curtis Doucet who was appointed the new Fire Chief in Port Hawkesbury during the Fire Department's General Meeting in December. Deputy Mayor Janega and Councilor Lewis extended congratulations and their support to Mr. Doucet. Mr. Doucet's report included the need to upgrade the utility vehicle, other equipment, and the limited capacity of the aerial truck. He commended the members and stated there were a minimal number of calls in January. Mr. Doucet was not opposed to the idea of amalgamation but recognized the separate identities of both departments. Mayor MacLean stated he looks forward to an invitation to a future meeting and thanked the former Fire Chief, Dale Sellars and outgoing members of the Executive for their many years of dedicated service.

c) Cultural Mapping Project

The Province and the Department of Communities, Culture and Heritage will develop a provincial cultural map to identify and record cultural resources to attract and support economic development within NS municipalities. Phase 1 of this project will partner the HRM with Port Hawkesbury.

MOVED by Deputy Mayor J. Janega and SECONDED by Councilor B. Lewis "To approve the Cultural Mapping Project as presented by P. Davis". MOTION CARRIED.

Tax Assessments

E. MacEachen addressed Deputy Mayor J. Janega's request to provide information on residential tax assessments, the Capped Assessment Program, payment options for residents, billing periods, rebates for eligible low income families, and the PVSC tax appeal process. Councilor B. Lewis suggested a breakdown of the allocation of tax dollars to inform residents. Deputy Mayor J. Janega stated the residents can be confident in the staff and Council's fiscal responsibility to its residents.
