1. Call to Order

A public meeting of the Port Hawkesbury Town Council was held in Shannon Studio, PHCC, Tuesday, December 6, 2016 and called to order by Mayor Brenda Chisholm-Beaton at 7:00 p.m. A moment of silence was observed to commemorate the 25th anniversary of those students who lost their lives at the École Polytechnique, Montréal, December 6, 1989.

2. Gallery Presentations

a) St. Martha's Regional Hospital Foundation – Fundraising Effort

St. Martha's Regional Hospital Foundation launched a fundraising effort with corporate, family (St. Martha's Hospital and Foundation) and community participation with a goal to raise \$20 million for their endowment by 2026. The presentation by Mr. Steve Smith, Mr. Joe MacDonald and Dr. Mike Silver addressed the need to purchase and provide training for new equipment and technology to keep the hospital modern, maintain services and to support the growing needs of communities and the hospital. Town Council was asked to join the County and Town of Antigonish by organizing door-to-door visits for pledges of support and a consideration of a 10-year pledge to the campaign. Discussion included contribution options through industry payroll deductions and the provision of training sessions by foundation team members. On behalf of Council, Mayor Chisholm-Beaton thanked Mr. Smith and his guests for their presentation. Council will deliberate on the request for a 10-year pledge to the campaign.
