TOWN SEAL BY-LAW

- 1. The common seal of the Town, made of metal, having engraved on it "Town of Port Hawkesbury, NS, Incorporated 1889" shall be the Town Seal.
- 2. The Seal shall be kept by the Clerk.
- 3. It shall be used when authorized by any statute, or by any by-law of the Town or by directions or resolution of the Council.
- 4. All deeds or documents to which the Town is a party and to which a seal is requisite, shall be authenticated by the Town seal and the Mayor and Town Clerk shall when duly authorized sign such deeds or documents and affix the seal thereto.
- 5. The following from may be used when any document is to be so authenticated:

- 6. The Mayor or Clerk may affix the Seal to any proper certificate or document at the request of the person desiring it.
- 7. Persons requiring the Seal to authenticate documents shall pay to Town the sum of \$3.00.
