These repairs are crucial to maintaining the quality and safety of our roads, and we appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this time.

### **Affected Locations:**

- Crandall Drive (From Hydrant by #16 to Grants Court)
- Spruce Street/Pine Ridge Intersection
- Sydney Road (Near Civic #113)
- Queen Street (From 613 Queen to Kennedy Street)
- Bernard Street (From Kennedy Street to Sydney Road)
- **Hiram Street** (From Philpott Street to MacSween Street)
- MacSween Street (From Prince Street to Hiram Street)

 Expected Duration: 2 weeks

### **Important Information for Residents:**

- **Temporary Road Congestion:** Please be advised that there may be temporary congestion and minor delays in the areas where work is being carried out. Traffic control measures will be in place to ensure the safety of both workers and residents.
- **Parking Restrictions:** In some cases, parking may be temporarily restricted in the work zones. Please adhere to any posted signage and instructions from traffic control personnel.
- Access to Properties: Access to driveways and properties will be maintained as much as
