- **Temporary Road and Sidewalk Closures:** Some sections of sidewalks and roads may be temporarily closed to accommodate construction work. - **Parking Restrictions:** Parking may be temporarily restricted in the affected areas. Please observe posted signage and instructions from on-site personnel.
- Access to Properties: We will strive to maintain access to driveways and properties; however, there may be brief periods when access is limited. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.
- **Noise and Dust:** Some noise and dust are expected during construction. We will take steps to minimize any disruptions and appreciate your understanding.
