#### 1. Call to Order

A Public Meeting of the Port Hawkesbury Town Council was held in the Shannon Studio and virtually on Tuesday, January 7, 2025, and called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor, B. Chisholm-Beaton.

#### 2. Additions to Agenda

#### 4. Gallery Presentations

Tamarac Education Centre Playground Committee – Karen Hood-MacKinnon

Karen introduced herself and the committee members. During the presentation she showed a recent photo of the Tamarac Playground and the history of the past playground equipment from 2020. The Tamarac Education School playground equipment was removed in 2020. The committee was formed in 2021, and they were given \$5,000 from the Strait Regional Centre for Education. She stated that the two playground spaces were also removed in the Tamarac subdivision during that time as well and expressed the need for an outdoor play space in the area. She noted that the TEC space is used outside of school hours by multiple community organizations. She reviewed some of the fundraising effort that have taken place to date and stated that there is not many funding avenues that are a good fit for the committee. She reviewed the advocacy that the committee continues to do to the Department of Education on the lack of funding avenues for school

playgrounds. She reviewed some of the upcoming fundraising events that are planned for this Spring. K. MacKinnon stated that the committee is looking for a letter of support from the Town to assist with their application for the Recreation Facility Development Grant through the Province of Nova Scotia. She also noted that the committee would not be as successful as it has been without the support of the small business community in the Town. There was a Q&A following the presentation. Council congratulated the committee on their efforts and expressed their support and advocacy for the project. Deputy Mayor, I. Langley asked how long it took to raise the funds. The school holds the funds. There was a question about the not for profit organization.

MOVED by Councillor, B. MacQuarrie and SECONDED by Deputy Mayor, I. Langley "That the Town of Port Hawkesbury send a letter of support for Tamarac Education Centre Playground Committee for the application to the Recreation Facility Development Grant." MOTION CARRIED.
