NO BAG LIMIT, CLEAN AND DRY

- All beverage containers
-
- All milk containers
-
- Glass bottles and jars (*lids off*)
-
- Plastic bottles, jars and containers
-
- Shampoo, conditioner, body wash bottles
-
- Cleaning fluid and laundry detergent jugs (*no boxes*)
-
- Salad dressing, condiment, dish soap, mouthwash bottles
-
- Cosmetic containers
-
- Toothpaste, deodorant and hand-cream tubes
-
- Small rigid packaging (*plant pots, sanitizer bottles*)
-
- Yogurt and pudding containers
-
- Fruit, veggie, bakery, cookie & cake trays
-
- Peanut butter, deli, bakery and egg containers
-
- Plastic cups, tubs and lids
-
- Bread, grocery, shopping and dry-cleaning bags
-
- Newspaper and flyer bags
-
- Sandwich and freezer bags
-
- Plastic wrap and shrink film
-
- Hot and cold beverage cups (*Tim's and takeout cups*)
-
- Ice cream containers, candy dispensers *ex: Kinder eggs*
-
- Spiral cans (*chip cans, cookie dough tubes*)
-
- Drink cartons (*juice, soy/oat/almond drinks*)
-
- Other paper-plastic laminate containers
-
- Aluminum and steel cans
-
- Aluminum pie plates, foil & trays
-
- Foil lids (*yogurt, sour cream*) (Ball up foil together)

Blue Bag #2 Paper Materials

NO BAG LIMIT, CLEAN AND DRY

- Newsprint
-
- Paper egg cartons
-
- Phone books
-
- Shredded paper (*bagged separately*)
-
- Boxboard (*cereal & tissue boxes*)
-
- Envelopes (*incl. plastic windows*)
-
- File folders
-
- Flyers, magazines and catalogues
-
- Glossy flyers and paper
-
- Paper towel & toilet paper cores
-
- Corrugated cardboard (*flattened and bundled, no bigger than 2 ft x 2 ft*)
-
- Paper carry out trays (*must be clean and dry*)
-
- Paper bags, sugar and flour bags
-
- Muffin, burger, sandwich wraps
-
- Pizza boxes
-
- Paper plates
-
- Paper and gift bags, gift wraps
-
- Muffin or sandwich bags
-
- Laundry detergent boxes (*paper*)

FYI: Soiled/wet paper can contaminate a whole bag of dry, non-contaminated paper which will make the paper unable to be recycled.

Please place paper products contaminated with food residue in the green bin.



Green Carts Organic Waste

1 CART PER HOUSEHOLD

- Nuts and nut shells
-
- Vegetable and fruits
-
- Bread and baked goods
-
- Grains pasta and rice
-
- Coffee grinds, filters, tea leaves, tea bags, wooden stir sticks
-
- Egg shells, dairy products
-
- Mayo, salad dressings, jams, sauces and peanut butter
-
- Meat products
-
- Cooking oils, lards and fats
-
- Leaves, twigs and branches
-
- Grass clippings, hay
-
- Sawdust and wood shavings
-
- Soiled or wet paper: Towels and napkins
-
- Soiled paper plates

FYI: Do not place branches more than 2" in diameter in the cart or allow branches to keep the green cart lid open. The lid must be able to close.

Garbage Clear Bag

6 BAG LIMIT

-
- All soiled saran wrap, stretch wrap & aluminum foil
-
- Disposable diapers
-
- Personal hygiene products
-
- Tooth, hair & lint brushes
-
- Soiled clothing & textiles
-
- All craft materials, ribbons, bows, broken jewelry & photographs
-
- Crayons, markers, pencils & pens
-
- Used Kleenex, paper towels & tissues
-
- Broken glass, lightbulbs (*boxed and labelled for safety*)
-
- Kitty litter & bagged dog waste
-
- Cold ashes (*must be cold and bagged*)
-
- Coffee/tea pods (*Keurig-type*)
-
- Books (*consider donating if reusable*)
-
- Toys (*donate if reusable*)

Household batteries (AAA, AA, etc.) can be dropped off to Canadian Tire or the Port Hawkesbury Civic Centre for recycling.

Used oil can also be dropped off to Canadian Tire. *Their phone number is 902-625-1580.*

Full paint cans can be dropped off at the Enviro-Depot for recycling. Electronic peripherals can be dropped off at ROC Society. **Refer to divertns.ca for recycling guidelines and to our FAQ's for more details.**
